



Canada Games Coaching Opportunities

The Canada Winter Games is a tremendous experience for both players and coaches.....an opportunity of a lifetime!

Coaching applications are being accepted for the Squash Ontario Canada Games program. We are seeking two individuals, one male and one female, to lead our Canada Games program for the period June 2009 – 31 March 2011.

The 2011 Canada Winter Games are being held in Nova Scotia

The Canada Winter Games coaches will report to the Executive Director and to the Vice President Technical/Competitions

Qualifications:

- Must be a fully certified level 3 coach or be in the process of obtaining full level 3 certification which must be completed by January 2010.
- Demonstrated organizational, communication (verbal and written) and interpersonal skills
- Demonstrated ability to work in group and meeting environment
- Experience travelling with juniors and in working within a junior team training environment
- Prior experience at national level competitions would be valuable
- Experience coaching in a Team competition/environment
- Must currently be running a Junior program in Ontario

Responsibilities:

- Hold three training/team bonding camps – two in year one and one in year two for Canada Games Squad and/or Team as determined by the Junior Advisory Committee
- Travel with Canada Games Squad and Team to designated events as determined by the Junior Advisory Committee. In year one, the coaches may travel to the 2009 Canadian Junior Open, 2010 Canadian Junior Closed based on location of these events
- In year two, the coaches may travel to the 2010 Canadian Junior Open or the 2010 U.S. Junior Open or the 2010 Jesters Open
- Assist in selection of Canada Games Team, (based on selection criteria as established and published by the Junior Advisory Committee)
- Ensure that Canada Winter Games Squad and Team meet all Squash Ontario eligibility and selection criteria
- Be available for the week of the Canada Games (first week in March 2010)

Compensation: \$1,200.00 honorarium in year one (based on specific events attended in program as agreed by coach and Squash Ontario)
\$2,200.00 honorarium in year two (based on specific events attended in program as agreed by coach and Squash Ontario)

Travel expenses will be covered to designated Events

Evaluation: Coaches' performance will be evaluated in June 2010 and re-appointment to year two will be based on that evaluation.

Note: The successful coaches will be required to undergo a police check.

The deadline for application is July 1, 2009
