2010 ONTARIO WINTER GAMES

March 4 - 7

Approximately 3,300 athletes, coaches, managers and officials will take part in the 2010 Ontario Winter Games which are being hosted in communities within the beautiful Muskoka area of the province. The squash competition is being hosted in Sudbury.

Each of Squash Ontario's regions will field teams of 8 players. Each team will be comprised of a boy and girl under 19, a boy and girl under 17, a boy and girl under 15 and a boy and girl under 13. We are looking for coaches who would like to take part in a unique coaching experience.

Coaches and managers are required for the following regions:

Northern Ontario
Toronia
Central

Northwestern Ontario
Niagara
Ottawa

Southwestern Ontario
Western
Toronto & District

Roles and Responsibilities of the Coach and Manager

- ❖ Develop the selection process for the team including format, who will make the selections
- ❖ Arrange for selection venue
- ❖ Provide the selection date and venue to Squash Ontario on or before 1 October for circulation to all junior athletes within the region
- ❖ The coach will be responsible for holding at a minimum a one day try out **on or before January 13, 2010** and for any additional team training
- ❖ Establish and utilize e-mail communications with team, parents and Squash Ontario
- ❖ Work with regional volunteers to fund raise to cover cost of team uniforms/be responsible for ordering the uniforms
- ❖ The coach and a manager (of the opposite gender) will travel with the team to Sudbury to compete in the Games.

The coach of the regional team must be **fully certified at level 2** or have CBET comparable certification and the manager must have **level 1 certification** or have CBET comparable certification.

Police checks for both coach and manager will be required

Squash Ontario will pay a coaching honorarium of **\$400.00** and an honorarium of **\$300.00** to the manager although regions may wish to augment that amount. Accommodation and food is provided through the Ontario Winter Games.

The Ontario Winter Games are help Squash Ontario not only develop its athletes, but also develop its coaches. OWG coaches from the past have gone on to coach Canada Games and national teams and squads.

Squash Ontario will make the appointments of coach and manager for each region no later than 1 September. This will give the coaching team an excellent opportunity to not only select its team early but also to schedule several training and bonding camps.

Where applications are not received for specific positions, Squash Ontario will appoint qualified individuals to the position.
