



The Jesters Club

The Jesters Club is international in scope and comprises a group of people who enjoy playing games in courts with walls “in a spirit not unworthy of the name of the club”.

The games are:

- Tennis
- Rackets
- Squash
- Eton Fives
- Rugby Fives

The Club is centred in the United Kingdom but also has many members in the United States, Canada, South Africa and Australia.

In Canada, the Club is organized along geographic lines into five regions - Atlantic, Quebec, Ontario, Western and Pacific, each managed by its own committee, with the national committee coordinating the whole.

Members play games amongst themselves and promote their sport through games with schools, universities and other clubs. In Canada, squash is the primary game played.

As well as playing matches, the Canadian arm of the Jesters Club works to develop the squash skills and sportsmanship habits of young men and women, which it does in various ways. In Ontario, this currently takes the form of sponsoring various junior tournaments and activities through Squash Ontario and by the efforts of individual Jesters on behalf of worthy juniors.
