In order to participate in a Squash Ontario Provincial Championship event, Ontario residents must be an individual member of Squash Ontario. Players who reside in Ontario, but are not members and wish to participate in any Provincial Championship event will be required to pay the individual membership fee in addition to the entry fee. Players residing outside of Ontario do not have to be members of Squash Ontario, but members in good standing with their provincial, territorial, or state and national squash association.

NEW Registration Policy:

If only one partner has completed registration/payment for the tournament by the Entry Deadline, the credit card of that participant will be charged for their partner's tournament fee (and Squash Ontario membership if required).

Refund Policy:

Withdrawals after draw preparation will receive no refund.

Eyeguard Policy:

All players must appropriately wear eyeguards made of polycarbonate or similar materials designed for protection in sport.

Defaults:

Anyone defaulting from the event and who would be eligible to receive prize money will not receive that prize money unless a doctor's note is presented to the Tournament Chair or a representative of Squash Ontario on the day of the defaulted match.
