

Anti-Doping Policy

Approved by the Squash Ontario Board of Directors May 27, 2022.

Position Statement

Squash Ontario is unequivocally opposed, on ethical, medical and legal grounds, to the practice of doping in sport, and fully supports the policies of Squash Canada, the World Anti-Doping Agency, International Olympic Committee, the World Squash Federation, Sport Canada and the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport (CCES) prohibiting the use of banned substances and methods.

Squash Ontario adheres to the anti-doping programs and standards set forth by Squash Canada with the Canadian Centre for Ethics in Sport.

In support of the CCES Canadian Anti-Doping Program Squash Ontario will:

- Assist in the promotion and facilitation of education programs driven by Squash Canada;
- Assist in identifying the pool of athletes subject to testing;
- Uphold and impose any penalties determined by the Doping Tribunal for an anti-doping rule infraction, with the Board deciding whether it should take any further action; and
- Provide the CCES with accurate and reliable information on athletes' whereabouts when requested.
