OPEN HOUSE CAMPAIGN

Introducing Squash Ontario's Sport Development Coordinator, Zoraiz Zakir

- Coordinating Open House Campaigns for participating clubs this Fall (must be an upgraded Project 10K member - connect with Lynsey to learn more)
- Ex. World Squash Day
- Working one-on-one with clubs to set up their events.
- Investing in social media advertising & outreach to fill registration for these events
- Squash Ontario will do the majority of the promotion work, with club coaches and volunteers to facilitate the day-of operations
- Developing on-boarding member best practices
- Final reports will be compiled with participant surveys to determine best practices, share results and repeat annually

SCHOOL SQUASH

- Equipment loans to schools for physical education classes
- Email distribution lists of schools and teachers to promote this program
- Accompanying <u>curriculum and resources</u> to teach the sport
- Squash Ontario will hire a local coach as requested by the school to start a squash unit
- Opportunity for coaches/volunteers to go into the schools and recruit new junior members for their club

ADULT SPORT & SOCIAL CLUBS

- Work with pre-existing adult sport & social clubs (ex. Toronto Sport & Social Club) to launch squash leagues if they don't have this yet.
- At present, the Toronto Sport & Social Club runs squash leagues at Mayfair Lakeshore, which often fill up!

CANADIAN INCLUSIVITY SQUASH PROGRAM


- Thanks to Canadian Tire Sport Relief Fund, we've received funds to support the launch of squash programs for children and youth with a disability, following the successful example from NFLD.
- At least two locations to be launched by January.

MULTI-SPORT SUMMER CAMPS

- Work with pre-existing multi-sport summer camps to adopt squash.
- Equipment available on loan
- Coach instruction
- Bursaries for new program coach certification

UNDER-REPRESENTED POPULATIONS

- Working with Squash Ontario's new Gender Equity & Inclusion Committee, Squash Ontario will be developing plans to increase participation rates of underrepresented populations in all areas of our sport: players, referees, coaches, etc.
